U. S. Scientist Sees New Ice Age Coming

The world could be as little as 50 or 60 years away from a disastrous new ice age, a leading atmospheric scientist predicts.

Dr. S. I. Rasool of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration and Columbia University says that:

 "In the next 50 years," the fine dust man constantly puts into the atmosphere by fossil fuel-burning could screen out so much sunlight that the average temperature could drop by six degrees.

If sustained over "several years" — "five to 10," he estimated—"such a temperature decrease could be sufficient to trigger an ice age!"

These conclusions—including the ominous exclamation point rare in scientific publication — are printed in this week's issue of the journal Science out today, signed by Rasool and co-worker Dr. S. H. Schneider,

They are also being presented by Schneider at an international Study of Man's Impact on Climate now being held in Stockholm as a prelude to a world environmental conference there next June.

Dr. Gordon F. MacDonald, scientist-member of President Nixon's three-man Council on Environmental Quality, said in an interview that these conclusions point up "one of the serious problems" U.S. and other delegates must address next year,

He called Rasool "a firstrate atmospheric physicist" whose estimate that fuel dust could drop temperatures by six degrees "is consistent with estimates I and others have made."

Whether this could cause an ice age "within five or 50 years or even more," he said, "I wouldn't want to guess."

But he "agreed completely" with Rasool that is is now urgent to start an international network to monitor atmospheric dust.

be simply necessary for men to stop most fossil fuel-burning—use of coal, oil, natural gas and automobile gasoline—and switch in the main to nuclear energy, despite the atom's own disadvantages. Pollution controls alone, he said, cannot do the job. "I think you have to stop the source."

A new ice age would flood the world's coastal cities and further lower temperatures to build up new glaciers that could eventually cover huge areas.

Scientists have long debated whether man's activity is actually heating or cooling the earth, if either. A "1970 Study of Critical Environmental Problems" concluded that the Rasool Schneider kind of prediction was impossible to make yet.

"The area of greatest uncertainty," that study concluded, is "our current lack of knowledge" of the optical properties of man-made dust "in scattering or absorbing turnadiation of the worlder



World is getting cooler

Droughts, floods, blizzards, tornadoes, typhoons and hurricanes have plagued much of the nation and the world in recent years. Most people considered these weather conditions to be abnormal and temporary, but instead, climatologists now believe that the first half of the Twentieth Century was blessed with unusually mild weather and that the global climate has begun returning to a harsher — but more normal — state.

For the long run, there is mounting evidence of a worldwide cooling trend. The average temperature of the world as a whole has dropped by one-third to one-half a degree Centigrade in the last 30 years. "The decline of prevailing temperatures since about 1945 appears to be the longest-continued downward trend since temperature records began," says Professor Hubert H. Lamb of the University of East Anglia in Britain.

Global cooling may be a cause of the devastating African drought, now in its sixth year. Some scientists believe that expansion of the cold polar air caps pushed the monsoon rain belt southward, causing many of the life-giving rains to fall on already fertile lands or into the sea. Dry weather conditions also prevail in parts of India, China, Kenya, Bolivia and other countries on both sides of the equator, raising the specter of even more serious drought and famine. Drought has hit the United States regularly about every 20 years, and is due again in the mid-1970s.







On the one hand, as scientists we are ethically bound to the scientific method, in effect promising to tell the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but – which means that we must include all doubts, the caveats, the ifs, ands and buts. On the other hand, we are not just scientists but human beings as well. And like most people we'd like to see the world a better place, which in this context translates into our working to reduce the risk of potentially disastrous climate change. To do that we need to get some broad based support, to capture the public's imagination. That, of course, means getting loads of media coverage. 

Judith Curry, one of climate science's most vocal critics, is leaving academe because of what she calls the poisonous nature of the scientific discussion around human-caused global warming.

Curry, 63, is retiring from her tenured position as a professor at the School of Earth and Atmospheric Sciences at the Georgia Institute of Technology. She's instead going to focus on growing her private business, Climate Forecast Applications Network, which provides insights into climate and weather risks for agriculture and energy companies.











Global Temperature and Atmospheric CO2 over Geologic Time




The Sun Controls Earth's Climate




How large is the Sun compared to Earth?

Compared to Earth, the Sun is enormous! It contains 99.86% of all of the mass of the entire Solar System. The Sun is 864,400 miles (1,391,000 kilometers) across. This is about 109 times the diameter of Earth. The Sun weighs about 333,000 times as much as Earth. It is so large that about 1,300,000 planet Earths can fit inside of it. Earth is about the size of an average sunspot!










The Earth does not have a unique temperature. The rapidly falling temperature of the lower atmosphere (or troposphere) is a key part of the physics of the greenhouse warming.




Ocean holds 1,000 times more heat than atmosphere









Concordia Average Wind Speeds





Chanute Average Wind Speeds




